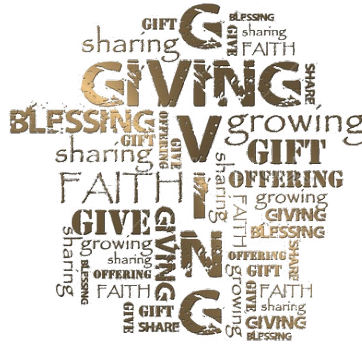

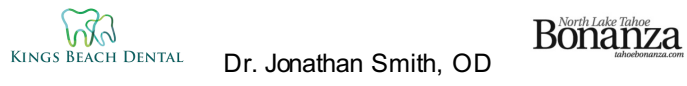
Tahoe Chocolate & Wine Festival Sets Fundraising Record
