The following programs require volunteers to complete 69 hours of training. Multilingual volunteers are needed for all programs. Please number in order of interest with "1" being most desired program to volunteer in:

- Helpline:* Provide crisis intervention and references by phone.
- Children:* Mentor youth affected by abuse through various weekly programs, utilizing pets, yoga, visual art, and outdoor programs.
- Safehouse:* Provide support to Safehouse residents of all ages and engage in cooking, homework help, budget creation, computer literacy, and other useful skills. Open to creative volunteer suggestions.
- Prevention:* Assist in educating local youth on violence prevention and healthy relationships, through support groups and in the classroom. Programs may include sexual harassment training for workplaces or self-defense classes.
- Empowerment Groups:* Assist staff in facilitating weekly empowerment groups for adult survivors of domestic abuse, sexual assault, and child abuse. Often utilizes Windows Between Worlds, a form of art therapy.
- Client Advocacy:* Assist clients in navigating the legal system by accompanying to appointments, court, document preparation, and transportation.

The following indirect service programs may require some on-the-job training:

- Outreach:* Get the word out through distribution of flyers, posters, safety cards, and other literature. Flexible schedule. Staff our information booth at community events.
- Office:* Assist staff with clerical work in Incline Village, Kings Beach, or Truckee. Monday-Friday 9 AM to 5 PM flexible.
- Fundraising:* Organize, decorate, promote, and perform at fundraising events. Participate in event planning committees. All talents needed.
- Friendraising:* Organize small home gatherings to hear the first-hand experiences of survivors of domestic violence and sexual assault. A great way to mobilize your friends in the grass-roots effort to prevent violence.
